Reversal of color perception and alteration of visual fields after defect acquired in a Commercial Pilot

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Identification

- Name: H. A. A. R.
- Age: 31 years (birth date15/02/1986)
- Male
- Place of birth: Cape-Verde



Reason for consultation

Disturbance in the transition from light to dark environments



Consultation with the Ophthalmologist (Aeronautical Medical Examiner)



History of current disease

- Started in April / 2013 (27 years)
- Visual disturbance in the transition from light to dark environments, with distortion of the image and feeling of "needing more time" for accommodation.
- Occasional red eye, predominantly left sided
- Denies ocular pain, ocular pruritus, excessive lacrimation



History of current disease

- Denies head trauma
- Denies drug use (licit and illicit)
- Personal history: Gastritis by H. Pylori in 2013 treated
- Unknown family history of hereditary pathology



April / 2013- Physical examination (general)

- ► Weight: 92.1kg
- → Height: 183cm (BMI 27,5)
- BP: 110 / 80mmHg HR: 62bpm
- Respiratory system without changes of normality
- Cardiac and vascular system, Abdomen and digestive system without changes of normality



April / 2013- Physical examination (general)

- Genito-urinary system without changes of normality
- Nervous and endocrine system without changes of normality
- No mention of behavioral deviations or psychological changes



April / 2013- Physical examination (Ophthalmology)

- ► Isometric and isochorical pupils
- Normal eye movements; Orthophoria (near and far)
- → Transparent Optical means
- Normal funduscopy
- ■Intraocular BP15/15 mmHg (RE / LE)
- Visual acuity 10/10 bilateral (at a distance); reading N5 at 30-50cm and N14 at 100cm (N-type near vision charts)

April / 2013- Physical examination (Ophthalmology)

- ► ISHIARA TEST 1/17
- → √isual fields confrontation altered (bilaterally)
- ← Visual fields computerized altered <u>left eye</u> / <u>right eye</u>

Actions - request confirmation of diagnosis to the Portuguese Civil Aviation Authority (Medical Department)

April / 2013- Physical examination (Ophthalmology- Portugal)

- Observation of eyes (aspect and eyelids; biomicroscopy) – normal
- ► Intraocular Blood Pressure 16 / 15mmHg (RE / LE) blowing method
- Visual acuity normal (near and far)
- Ophthalmoscopy abnormal (change not specified)



April / 2013- Physical examination (Ophthalmology- Portugal)

- Visual fields (confrontation) abnormal bilaterally
- ► Visual fields (computerized) <u>left eye</u> / <u>right eye</u>
- ► ISHIHARA TEST 24 errors (in 25 pictures) PROTOANOMALY



April / 2013- Physical examination (Ophthalmology- Portugal)

- Beyne Lantern Did not do the exam due to device malfunction
- Neuro-image exams not performed!



Diagnosis

► Likely:

■ Acquired Protoanomaly - Systemic disease?

Drug toxicity? Pigmentary Retinopathy?

■ Definitive - ??



Actions

- Cancellation of Medical Certificate
- Withdrawal of Flight Licenses



Currently

- Spontaneous reversal of the changes in 2 years
- In 2015 the Pilot returned to Portugal and underwent a new certification process, having been certified, in September, to Class 1 - Single Pilot Commercial Operations Carriyng Passengers and Class 2
- Submitted to the Aeronautical Medical Council, in Cape Verde, on April 4th 2017, having been admitted for **Class 1** operations Commercial Pilot License (for aircraft carreer)
